No Smoking Policy

Introduced: May 2014
Revised : March 2015

Implemented by : Board Members

NEED: Schools under the banner of **IQRA EDUCATION** will provide neat, clean and safe environment where good health is promoted. This policy will be operational in all schools run by **IQRA EDUCATION**. The Indian Academy, Dubai being one of the schools of **IQRA EDUCATION** will follow a “No Smoking” policy.

PROCEDURE:

- ❖ All **IQRA** school sites operate a “No Smoking” policy. Smoking is strictly prohibited on the school grounds, in the school buildings including toilets, corridors, reception area, swimming pool, staff rooms, car parks and playing fields.
- ❖ Smoking among adults on school premises, or by teachers during school hours, reinforces the idea that smoking is a normal adult activity and undermines strict prohibition among pupils.
- ❖ Smoking is prohibited during school programmes held outside normal school hours.
- ❖ Teachers, parent helpers and staff are expected to refrain from smoking on all school trips and events.
- ❖ All transport provided or contracted by the school must maintain a smoke free environment.
- ❖ Organisations and clubs who use the school premises outside of school hours are expected to adhere to the school’s No Smoking Policy.
- ❖ Parents and Guardians must be discouraged from smoking at entrances and exits to the school site whilst collecting their child.
- ❖ All staff is requested not to smoke in or around the school gates/walls or anywhere, where the parents and members of the public are affected.
- ❖ This policy applies to all staff, pupils, parents, visitors and contractors when they are at the school campus

Smoking in the Schools and around the campus is banned by the UAE Government and defaulters may face strict actions
