The adherence to school uniform improves learning by reducing distraction, sharpening focus on schoolwork and making the classroom a more serious environment, allowing students to perform better, academically as well as prepare them for the future when they go out in the world and work

in different spheres where wearing the uniform means that one is an integral member of the organization.

Wearing the school uniform strengthens the sense of discipline and inhibits the notion of being conscious about one's appearance. Uniform has practical benefits when students are outside the school building, being readily identified makes students more aware of their behaviour while travelling to and from the school, leading them to act more considerately particularly during organized trips away from the school. It is much easier for teachers to ensure they have not lost anyone and to monitor behavior in the larger crowd. Uniform prepares students for life after education.

### Reasons to have a school uniform:

- \* School uniforms promote uniformity within the school through wearing the same piece of clothing wherein students can feel a sense of unity.
- \* It provides a sense of belongingness and pride is cultivated too since school uniforms show which school one is from.
- \* School uniforms promote responsibility and discipline amongst students. They also learn the value of saving time.
- \* School uniform gives a distinct identity and makes all students look and feel equal to each other.
- \* Reduces unnecessary fashion distractions and contributes to the focus on teaching and learning.

## Uniform Care

### Skirts/ Half Trousers/ Full Trousers :

Wash at 40 C. Higher temperatures will cause shrinkage, affect the colour or weaken the fibres. Wash dark colours separately. Avoid strong fabric conditioners as they can break the fibres. Do not bleach.

Do not tumble dry pleated garments as the pleats will disappear. For best results simply drip dry after washing.

If you want to improve the creases, use a steam iron or a clean damp cloth, with a regular iron. Do not use a hot iron directly on the garment.

### PE Trousers/ PE T-shirt :

Always wash at 40 C. Higher temperatures will cause shrinkage, affect the colour or weaken the fibres. Wash dark colors separately. Avoid strong fabric conditioners. Do not bleach.

These clothes do dry very quickly if left to dry naturally, but if you want to tumble dry them ensure they are on a cool setting.

Ironing is not necessary for these clothes. However if you want to iron, use a cool iron setting and place a clean damp cloth between the garment and the iron. Do not iron directly on to the garment and do not use excessive heat as this makes the fabric brittle. Do not iron on the print or embroidery directly please iron on reverse.

### Shirts – Blouse :

Can be machine washed on a gentle polyester/easy care/delicate programmed up

to 40 C. Avoid strong fabric conditioners. Do not bleach.

These garments can be tumble dried on a cool/low setting. If the temperature is higher the fibres can be damaged and shrinkage may occur.

With these garments ironing is not always necessary if hung up after washing. However if you want a smart finish on the garment use the synthetic setting and iron directly on to the garment ironing is easier if the garment is slightly damp. Do not iron on the print or embroidery directly please iron on reverse.

### Shoe care - Black

Simply remove excess dirt with a cloth and / or a brush and apply the shoe polish.

Polish your shoes regularly and use a shoe tree or stuff a newspaper to retain the shape of the shoe. Never store shoes near direct heat.

### Shoe care - White

Avoid washing them in the washing machine. Always use a mild detergent and a soft brush to clean them and air dry the shoes after washing.

You may also use 'Scotchguard' type fabric protector for your shoes.
