POLICY ON IMMUNIZATION PROCEDURE

Purpose

Immunization is a proven tool for controlling and eliminating life threatening infectious diseases.

Target

School doctor, nurse, students and parents

Policy Statement

1. Manual Registration used for recording information about child immunization is maintained in the clinic.
2. Health Care Professional are able to articulate standard procedures in case of adverse events.
3. Severe adverse events forms are available.
4. Anaphylaxis Kit is available.
5. Inventory of Vaccines including expiry dates are available. (If applicable)
6. Health Care Professionals have immediate contingency plans in case of electrical failure or handling the extra vaccine. (If applicable)
7. Health Care Professionals know how to read vaccine vial monitor. (VVM)
8. DHA immunization guidelines are available and the concerned staff are oriented with the guidelines.
9. Vaccine carriers/boxes with sufficient ice packs and thermometers are available.

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
