Policy to be reviewed again in April 2024

- A student at TIAD is considered as an Arabic beginner when he/she joins school without learning Arabic as a Modern Foreign Language from Grade 2 onwards.
- Any student who has joined in the months of April to June from Grade 2 to Grade 4 is considered as a beginner from April to October, Term 1 of the academic year 2021-22.
- Any students who have joined from September 2021 onwards is considered as a beginner till the month of February 2022.
- Students are considered as beginners for one academic year only from Grade 5 to Grade 9.
- Students of Phase 3 & 4 who join from September 2021 will continue as beginners till June next year.
- Students who had studied Arabic and left Dubai for one year or more will be considered as beginners and have to abide all the points mentioned above.
- Low achievers/ need based students in Arabic cannot be considered beginners.
- Remedial lessons are provided for low achieving students within/beyond curriculum instruction time which is periodically reviewed.

School Policy of Arabic Department:

The beginners who have joined recently or started learning Arabic from the past two months, are considered as Low Achievers. Thus, beginners will be treated as low level, and study the same prescribed syllabus as other students. Decision will be made by the teacher's vision about the student's performance in the class.
