

POLICY OF ARABIC BEGINNERS

Policy Reviewed - March 2024 Date of Next Review - March 2025

Mission Statement:

The Arabic Department at The Indian Academy, Dubai is committed to providing high-quality. instruction in Arabic language and culture to foster linguistic proficiency, intercultural understanding, and global awareness among our students.

- A student at TIAD is considered an Arabic beginner when he/she joins school without learning Arabic as a Modern Foreign Language from Grade 2 onwards.
- Any student who has joined from April to June from Grade 2 to Grade 9 is considered a beginner for the entire Academic Year, 2024-25.
- Students who had studied Arabic and left Dubai for one year or more will be considered as beginners and have to abide by all the points mentioned above.
- Low achievers/need-based students in Arabic cannot be considered beginners. Remedial lessons
 are provided for low-achieving students within/beyond curriculum instruction time which is
 periodically reviewed.
- List of beginner students is maintained by the Arabic Teachers.
- Beginners' students of Arabic appear for Beginners classes and Beginners paper is separate for these students from Gr 2 onwards.

School Policy of Arabic Department:

The beginners who have joined recently or started learning Arabic in the past two months will also attend the Beginner's classes.

Decisions will be made by the teacher in synchronization with Arabic HOD, and SLT members about the student's performance in the class after completing the above-mentioned timeframe in the beginner's classes before moving to the regular classes.

Policy Review and Revision:

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Arabic department faculty and department head to ensure its effectiveness and relevance. Revisions may be made as needed to reflect changes in educational standards, institutional priorities, or other relevant factors.
