

# PROMOTION CRITERIA POLICY

## Rationale

At The Indian Academy Dubai, we aspire to ensure all our students achieve the highest academic outcomes/ skills in line with our mission and vision as a high-performing CBSE curriculum school.

## Explanation

As per the CBSE and KHDA /MOE guidelines 33% is the minimum passing marks. However, as per the TIAD rationale we work towards enabling each of our student to secure 51% and above to be in line with the Curriculum level expectations. The following statements explain our internal interventions to allow and support the student for a smooth transition and promotion.

1. As per the rationale and KHDA/ MOE guidelines, students who have secured 51% and above will be passed and promoted
2. Students who have secured more than 33% and less than 51% will be promoted with remedial support and intervention.
3. Students who have failed in 2 or less than 2 subjects will be promoted after retest in which they must score 33% or more in both the subjects.
4. Students who have failed in 3 or more core subjects will be detained
5. For the MOE subjects the pass criteria is as below:
  - i. Arabic – 50%
  - ii. Islamic – 50%
  - iii. Moral, Social, Cultural (MSC) – 40%

## KHDA Approved Requirements

Promotion criteria is based on the pass percentage required as per the prescribed curriculum standards which is 33% for all the subjects except MOE subjects.

## Example

Example	Status	Result
Student 1 (Grade 2)	Aleena in Grade 2 secured 55%	Aleena will be promoted to Grade 3.
Student 2 (Grade 6)	Hamdan in Grade 6 has secured 42%	Hamdan will be promoted to Grade 7 with remedial support and intervention.
Student 3 (Grade 8)	Justin in Grade 8 secured 25% in Maths and Science	Justin will be promoted after passing the retest.
Student 4 (Grade 9)	Arnav in Grade 9 secured 29% in 4 subjects	Arnav will not be promoted.
